
I am to refer to your RTI Application dated ,Nil, received in this Department on 6.12.2018.

Sub: Counting of two additional increments for the purpose of revision of pension w.e.f. 01.01.2016 in respect of pre-2016 Scientists/Engineers pensioners in D/o Space, D/o Atomic Energy and Defence Research & Development Organisation - regarding

Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare (DOP&PW) may please refer to their notes on preceding pages, recorded on their file No.38/1/18-P&PW(A), for approval of this Department to the formulation for fixation of pension of pre-2016 Scientists/Engineers pensioners in Department of Space (DOS), Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) and Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO).

2. In this context, it is brought to the notice of DOP&PW that Department of Expenditure, vide I.D. Note No.203607/E.III(A)/2013, dated 11.11.2013, had advised Department of Space to consider withdrawing these two additional increments immediately in view of the fact that the Performance Related Incentive Scheme (PRIS) had since been implemented in the light of the recommendations of the 6th CPC and as such there was no need to retain these two additional increments any longer. Subsequently, DRDO was also informed of the decision of the Government vide I.D. Note No.139934/E.III(A)/2014, dated 12.08.2014 and were requested to ascertain whether DOS has withdrawn the two additional increments as per the decision of Department of Expenditure.


3. Therefore, before the proposal of DOP&PW is considered, it would be important to know whether these Scientific Departments, viz, Department of Space, Department of Atomic Energy and DRDO had withdrawn the benefit of two additional increments and if so, from which date.

4. In the light of above, DOP&PW is requested to consult the three Scientific Departments to ascertain the factual position before formulating their proposal.


